

Policy statement

The aim of the Modern Slavery Act is to ensure that large businesses with an annual turnover of more than £36 million monitor and control their operations and supply chains and keep them free from human trafficking and slavery.

As a small business we aim to highlight that Story Decorating Group Limited has a zero-tolerance attitude and is committed to preventing acts of modern-day slavery and human trafficking both within our business or our supply chain in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Our company is aware of the Modern Slavery Act, including definitions of the terms within and we are mindful what to do if we suspect a case, this includes a review of our whistle-blowing policy.

We aim to ensure modern slavery does not exist within our direct employment and recognise, by way of our approved subcontractor / supplier procedures, that we need to be vigilant in who we appoint as subcontractors and suppliers now and in the future.

We recognise the need to work with CIS registered subcontractors only to reduce the risk of modern-day slavery and are committed to procuring our materials through an approved supply chain who in turn take responsibility to take the prevention of modern slavery very seriously.

Our objectives

We fully intend to maintain and continuously improve all of our policies whilst ensuring these changes are fed down to our employees through training, including how to identify any potential issues. We will continue to communicate with our employees to highlight the importance of the issues.
